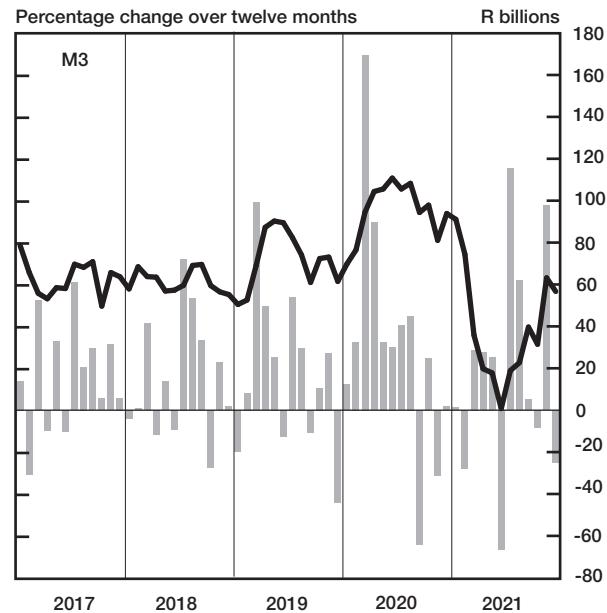

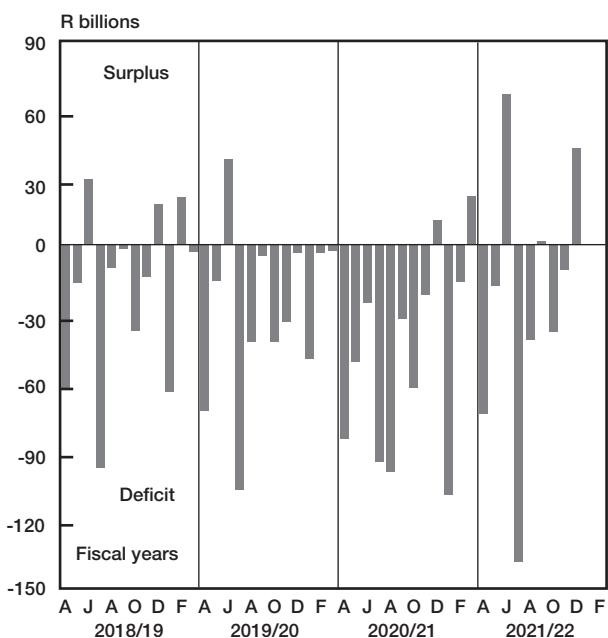

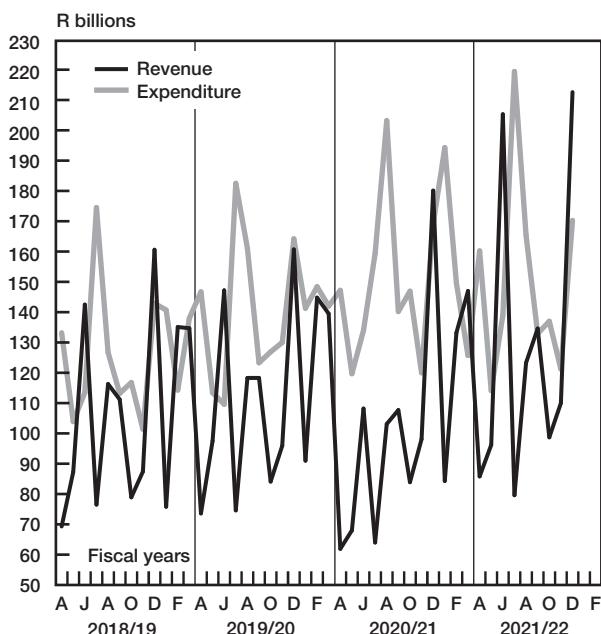

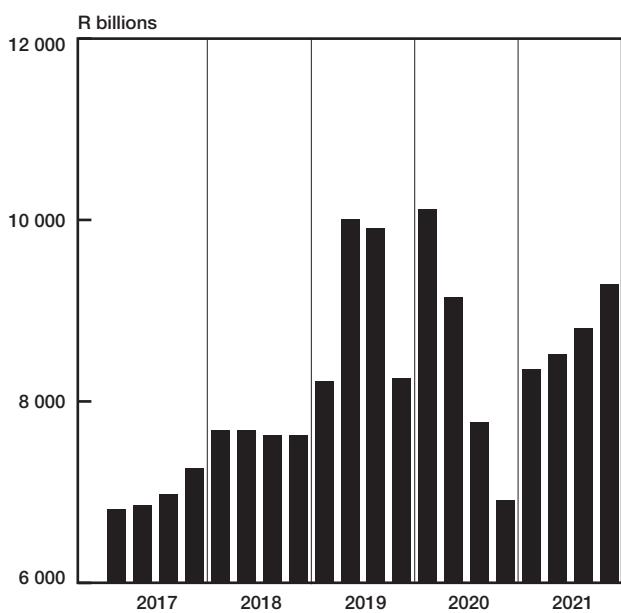
National government balance adjusted for cash flows



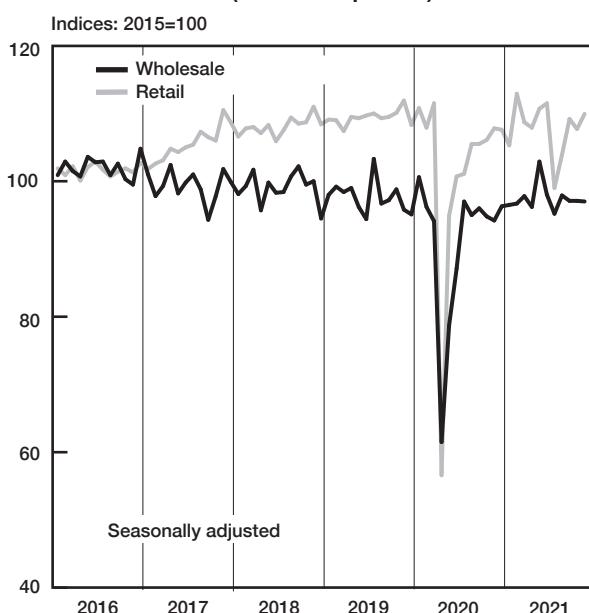
National government finance adjusted for cash flows



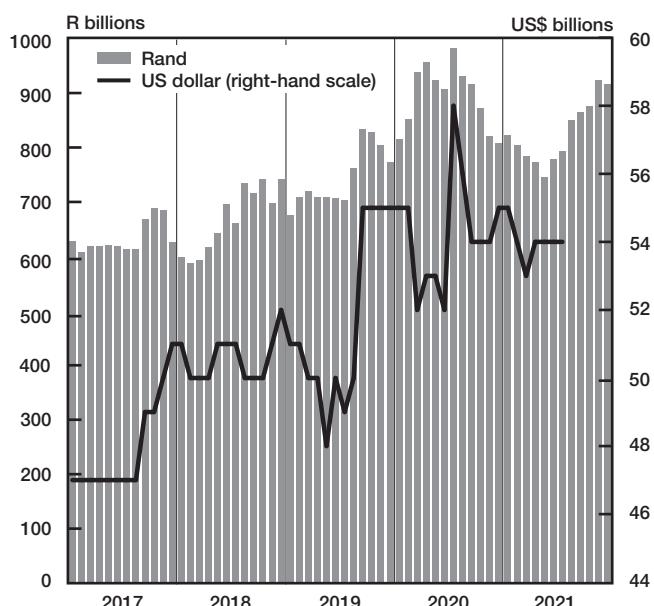
Turnover in the secondary bond market
